

## 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Supply List 2019 – 2020

Welcome to MS 447! Student preparedness for class is important for success. Below is a list of supplies that your student will need in 6<sup>th</sup> grade. We recommend that you label items with your student's first and last name on the front cover.

### **6<sup>th</sup> Grade School Supplies. These come to school!**

- 1 Pencil Case containing the following supplies:
  - 1 pack of highlighters
  - 1 pack of pens (either blue or black ink)
  - 1 Hand-held pencil sharpener that collects shavings (small metal one works best)
  - 1 pack of loose-leaf ring reinforcement stickers
- One **1.5-inch hardcover binder** (NO Trapper Keepers, rubberized edges, zipper closed or cloth binders. Please only standard sized binders). Please, **DO NOT set up the binder at home** – we'll do this at school! Avery Heavy Duty Binders are the best. Please don't put the pencil case or the MS447 Planner inside the binder.
- 1 pack of **8 Tabbed Dividers** for binders
- 1 Reusable water bottle
- 4 Marble Composition notebooks (no spirals and should have a hard cover) with student's name on them
- 1 Orange Plastic 2-Pocket Folder with student name on it
- 1 Green 2-Pocket Folder (plastic or sturdy) with student name on it
- 1 Blue Plastic 2-Pocket Folder with student name on it
- 1 Red 2-Pocket Folder with student name on it
- 1 Purple 2-Pocket Folder with student name on it
- 2 packs of Dixon Ticonderoga pencils (each pack with at least 12 pencils in each)
- 1 package of erasers
- 1 pack of plastic Post-It flags (the flags, not the larger regular Post-Its)
- One 1-inch binder for Expo.
- 1 Combination Lock (**please memorize the combination and practice unlocking it over the summer!**)
- 1 MS 447 Agenda Book/Planner (given out on the first day of school at a cost of \$5)

### **6<sup>th</sup> Grade Supplies for HOME. KEEP THESE AT HOME!**

These are supplies that will make it easier for your student to do their work at home. You might already have these supplies left over from elementary school and you can reuse them. ☺ Please do not bring these to school.

- A stapler and staples
- Crayons or colored pencils or markers. Sometimes your student will need to color something!
- Scissors and tape or any type of glue
- Pencils or pens and erasers

**Donations:** We have decreased the supplies we request in order to be mindful of cost and the environment. While we may ask for classroom supply donations at a later date, if you are able, we humbly request that you consider making a monetary donation to help defer costs for the Camp Bernie trip, so that we can make sure that all children have the opportunity to attend, regardless of cost. We will gladly accept any donation, big or small. It goes a long way to making MS 447 a truly inclusive community. ## The First Two Days of School List

The first few days of school are exciting for middle school students! However, we don't want people to bring extra things that aren't necessary for these two days. These lists are to help you coordinate when to send in the supplies that are on the previous list. These are not more things to purchase.

### Day 1: What should my Student Bring?

- A smile ☺
- The 1.5 Inch Binder
- The 8 Tabbed Divider pack for their binder
- Pencil Case already filled with one of the pens, highlighters, sharpener, and reinforcers from the packs. You don't need every pen or highlighter to permanently live in the pencil case. Just put 1 or 2 inside to start off with.
- The Combination Lock
- Reusable Water Bottle
- Lunch
- Backpack
- Their home or cell phone **NUMBER** memorized or written down for them to look at
- The \$5 for the Planner

### Day 2: What should my Student Bring?

- A smile ☺
- Their School Wide Book Club Book (*The Boy Who Harnessed the Wind*)
- Their MS 447 Agenda/Planner (given out on Day 1)
- Pencil Case
- Reusable Water Bottle
- Lunch
- Backpack

- Any **Supply or Camp Bernie Donations** should be brought in on **Day 2 or later**. Guardians can also drop off the binder donations in the Main Office labeled SIXTH GRADE or send it in your student with the label "Donation" attached. Camp Bernie Donations should be put in an envelope labeled "Camp Bernie Donation" and your student's name & class. Your student should give it to their 1<sup>st</sup> period teacher.
- **The Rest of the School Supplies** should be brought on **Day 3**. Your teachers will expect that you will have these items then and collect them starting on Day 3. **Make sure your student's name is on the front of each.**
  - 4 Marble Notebooks with student's name on the front
  - All the folders with your student's name on them: Purple, Orange, Blue, Green folders
  - Your Post-It flags
  - 2 packs of pencils
  - Your eraser pack
- On the 1<sup>st</sup> E or F Day, bring in the RED folder and the 1-inch binder for Expo.
