President

- A 7th grade parent offered to coordinate a holiday breakfast for teachers. However, Arin mentioned that her budget cannot accommodate the annual teacher holiday party this year. Sarena/Treasurer says we have a \$2,000 budget for staff appreciation for holiday events and Arin expects the party to come in below that, between \$1400-\$1600. The PTA will fund the party and put a hold on a teacher breakfast for now.
