The test will take place at **MS 447 on October 30, 2024, starting at 8:30 AM**. Students will now receive their tickets on the morning of the test. All students will receive the testing accommodations that are indicated on their 504 and IEP.

Following are the directions to register for the SHSAT

1. Log in to your MySchools account
2. Click Get started on the SHSAT registration
3. Select the specialized high schools you want to be considered for in order of preference
4. Submit your registration

You will receive an email receipt for your registration.
